Notes to assist YOU with your registration

REGISTRATION DETAILS

- Contact details are collected for festival administration purposes and networking with other festival participants. Please indicate if you do NOT want your details shared
- For catering purposes all registrants requiring lunches must register and pay by 28 May
- 'On the day' registrations will be **exclusive** of lunch (there are a range of cafes and lunch bars in the vicinity)

FEES

- Student fee is 50% of the non-member adult fee. A copy of your student ID is required with your registration (festival workshops not suitable for primary school-age children)
- The fee for the full festival includes all workshops; lunches Sat/Sun; all refreshments; social events Saturday & Sunday evenings; Monday revision workshop
- **Full Day Fee includes** all morning and afternoon workshops; refreshments; lunch; and evening social event on the day of registration
- Full Day Fee does not include entry to Monday revision workshop
- **Single session** or half day registrations are exclusive of lunches
- Just want to watch? There is a non-participant observer fee of \$5 (for each workshop / session) payable on the day. This includes refreshments during the session but not other session refreshments or lunches
- Social evenings Children under 13 yrs no charge

REFUND POLICY

- A full refund will be made if advised to festival organisers before 16 April 2010
- 50% refund will be made if advised after 16 April and before 28 May
- No refunds will be made after 28 May 2010.

MEDIA

- Resources ordered before 28 May 2010 will be available in registration packs.
- Media resources ordered at the festival may incur an additional postage and packing charge
- The DVD content will be limited to dance repertoire taught at the workshops, and will be aimed at providing a 'refresher' for workshop participants
- Recording workshop content at the festival is not allowed
- Participants may take their own video footage of social events and festival fun if they wish
- We will not have videos or cassette tapes of the workshop repertoire available for purchase

WHAT ABOUT CHILDREN?

Festival workshops are not suitable for primary school-age children but they are welcome to attend the evening socials

DIRECTIONS

- Sacred Heart Girls College is on the corner of Firth St and Clyde Street in Hamilton East close to the junction (traffic lights) with Grey street. You can find a Google map at <u>http://folkdance.org.nz/camp10/venue.html</u> (or click on Venue link on the Festival home page).
- Common routes -
 - From South / East Find Cobham Drive and turn right into Grey Street opposite Hamilton Gardens Gate 2. Turn R at the traffic lights into Clyde Street. Sacred Heart is on the right
 - From North / West Find Cobham Drive, cross over the Waikato River on the Cobham Drive bridge then take the first left into Grey St opposite Gate 2 of the Hamilton Gardens. Turn R at the traffic lights into Clyde Street. Sacred Heart is on the right
 - From Hamilton CBD, cross over Victoria Bridge, stay in the left lane and turn right (into Grey St) at the lights opposite the Catholic Cathedral; then turn L at the next lights into Clyde Street Sacred Heart is on the right

PARKING

There is limited on-site parking and this will be restricted to festival organisers and guests. Street parking is available on Firth Street and in the Clyde Street shopping precinct

ACCOMMODATION

Motel and backpacker accommodation is available within 500m – 2 kms. These have been listed on the FDNZ website. Early 'pencil' booking is recommended.
